

NTGCR Scholarship Recipients Fall 2009 thru Spring 2023

Since the NTGCR first began awarding scholarships in the Fall of 2009 through the Fall 2023 semester, we have been able to help **44 students**. NTGCR has issued a **total of \$137,500.00** in scholarship monies to tribal students.

From the fall of 2012 through the fall of 2015 we put a hold on scholarships due to the lack of funding but were able to resume in the Spring of 2016. Out of the 44 recipients, 5 have received the Jess Green Scholarship.
